Hello Mighty Mite parents

Registration: Online registration is open. Please visit: http://alyeskamightymites.org/reg_forms.html
You can choose to either register on-line, or you can download the paperwork and send in the mail. The PO Box is on the website. Registration will continue to be open through the month of December, however, this year the **Mighty Mite program will be capped at 200 children for operational reasons.**

Registration fee: The annual fee for Mighty Mites has been raised. It is now **\$175 per child** for the season.

Payment: You can pay through Pay Pal online, or via check through the mail. Mighty Mites will accept payment through December at the RTC each Sunday. Please note, the grouping race is on January 8, and any child who has not paid by then will not be permitted to race.

Liability Forms: There are several new liability and safety forms for parents to complete and sign this year. Please be sure to download and complete those forms prior to December.

New children: Please note that all children new to Mighty Mites must try out through the Alyeska Mountain Learning Center (ski school). Information on this process can be found on our website. Animal Groups:

All returning children will ski with their LAST YEARS animal group until the grouping race, which will be a two run race, to include a slalom and giant slalom run, held on Sunday **January 8th**. All children will be set into their groups for the season. Any child who misses the grouping race will be placed in an animal group through coach recommendation.

Recent 10 years olds will be placed in the COUGAR group until the grouping race where the groups will be reorganized again.

New children to the program, after they have passed the Mighty Mite Hopeful tryouts, will most likely start out as either Chipmunks (age 7-9) or Cougars (age 10-12) until the grouping races and then all children will be reorganized into an animal group according to their age and ability.
